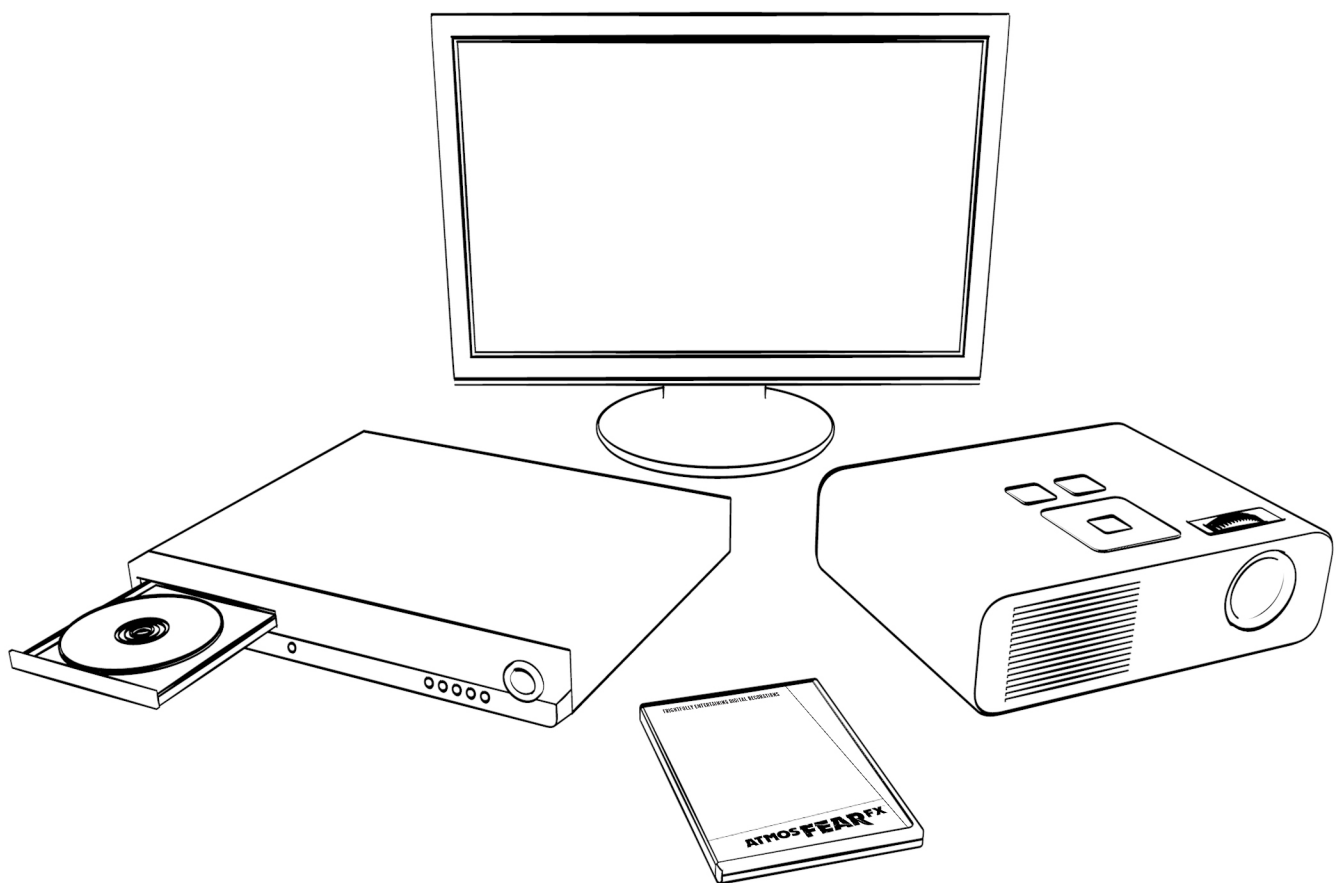


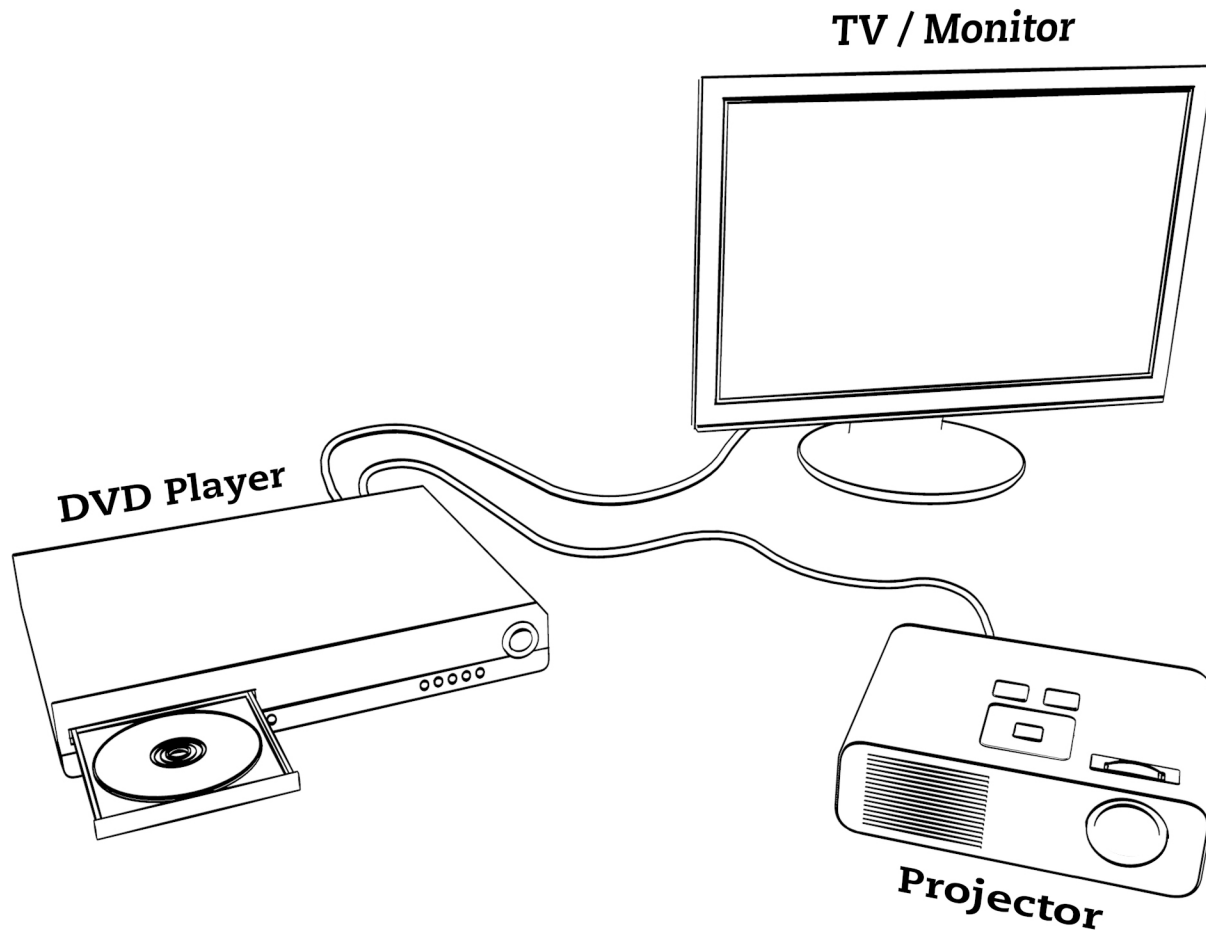

GENERAL

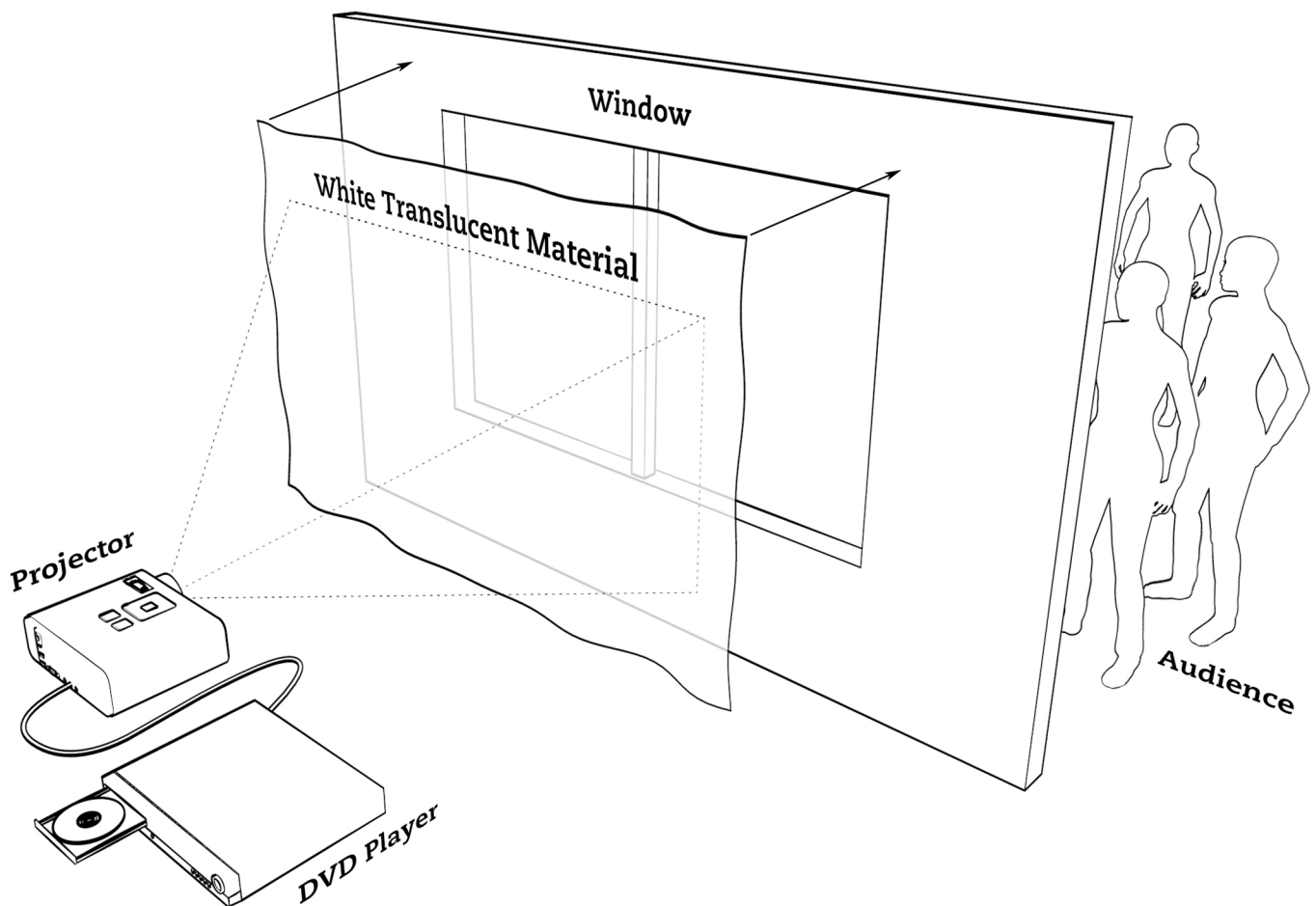
- AtmosFX digital decorations are utilized with a DVD player and TV, monitor or projector.



- Most AtmosFX decorations contain multiple effects, display modes, a soundtrack and can loop continuously.
- Use the simple DVD menu to customize and play your effects.
- Hiding your display device and DVD player creates a seamless illusion.

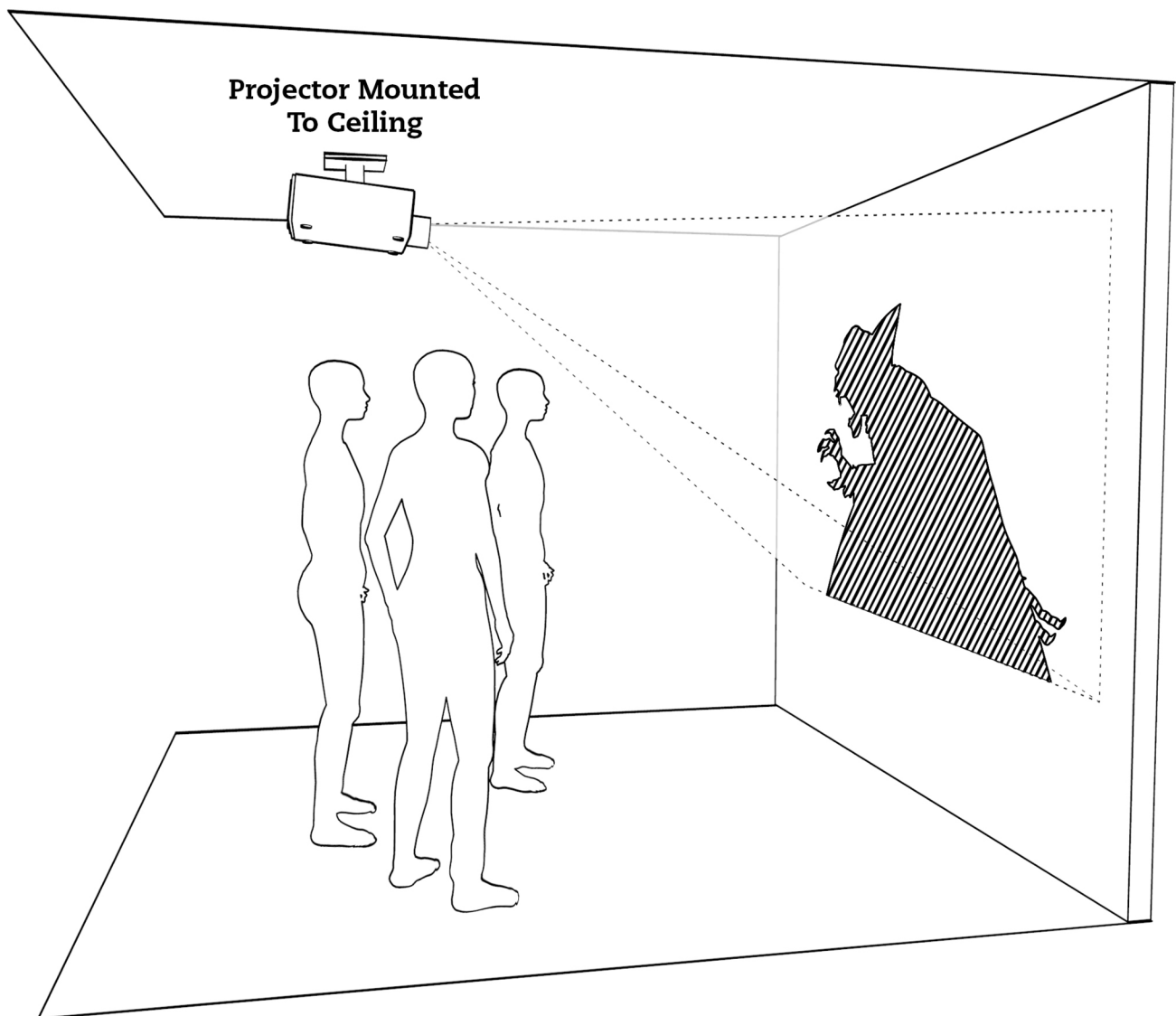
USING A PROJECTOR

- Short throw projectors are advantageous in small spaces ranging from 2' to 5'.
- Recommended minimum lumens is 1800, depending on a room's ambient light.
- Projector settings like keystone, focus, aspect and reverse projecting may improve your display.
- For rear projection into a window, use translucent material like a white bed sheet, shower curtain, or even window projection decaling.



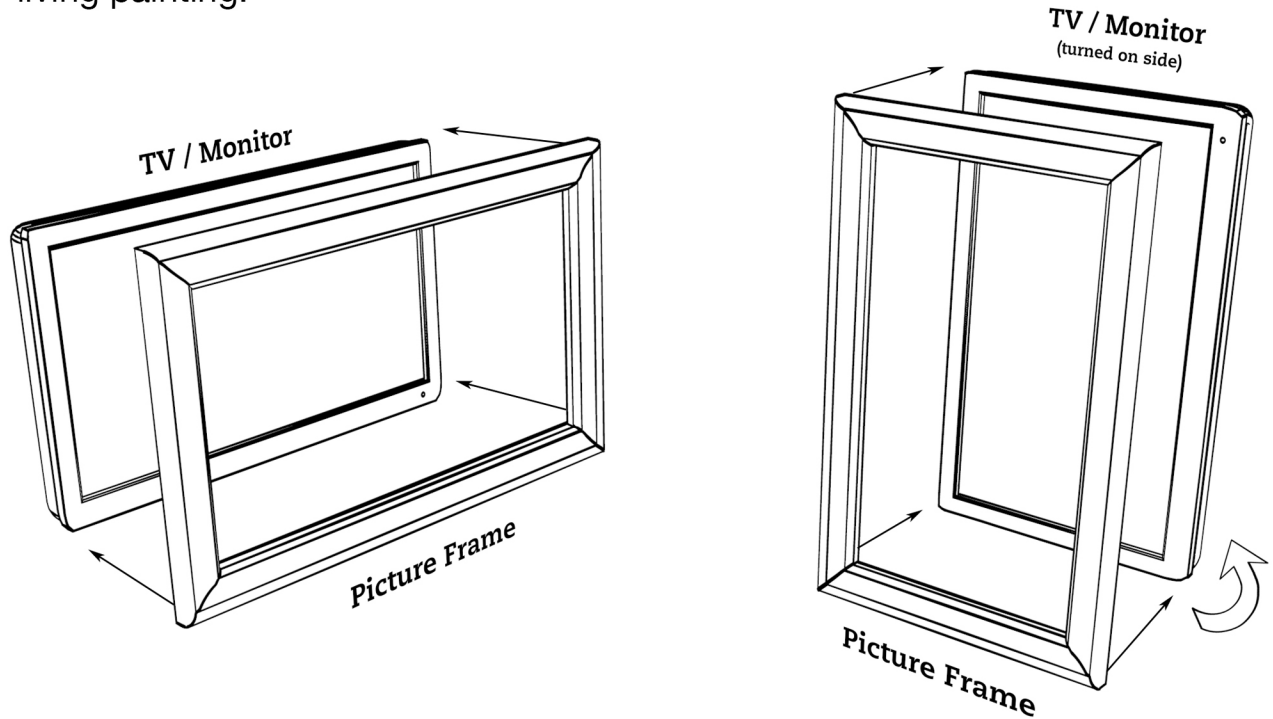
USING A PROJECTOR (CONTINUED)

- When projecting onto a wall, floor or ceiling, light colored surfaces work best.
- When projecting in areas with high foot traffic, it is ideal to mount your projector from the ceiling to avoid obstruction of the beam.

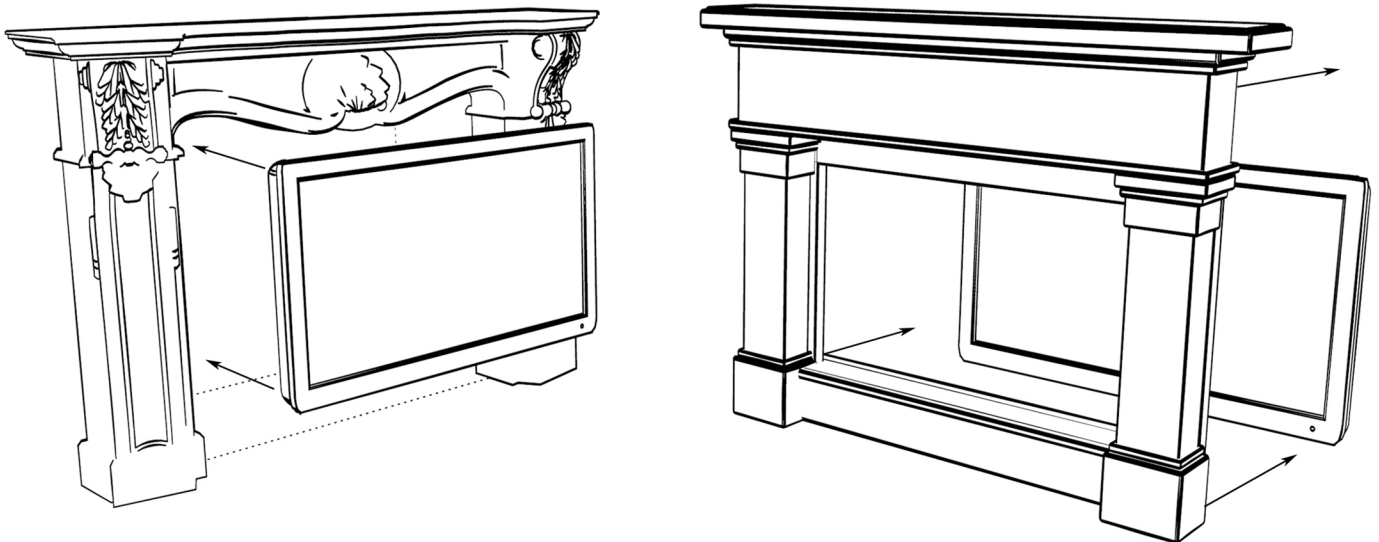


USING A TV / MONITOR

- High resolution LCD and LED monitors are small, lightweight and easily fit into any space.
- Add a picture frame to hide the border of your TV and create the illusion of a living painting.



- Hide your TV in a fireplace or create a faux fireplace border.



USING A TV / MONITOR (CONTINUED)

- Use a large TV to create the impression of a window. Add a faux window frame, shutters, or some curtains to complete the illusion.
